Holiday Recipes

Gingerbread Fudge

3 cups dark chocolate chips or white chocolate chips 1 14-oz. can sweetened condensed milk

1/4 cup molasses 1 tbsp. butter 1 tsp. vanilla extract

1-1/2 tsp. ground ginger 1 tsp. ground cinnamon

3/4 tsp. nutmeg 1/2 tsp. allspice

1/2 tsp. ground cloves

Line an 8x8 pan with aluminum foil and lightly grease or butter the foil. Set aside. Combine

chocolate chips, condensed milk, molasses, and butter in a mediumsized saucepan over medium heat. Stir frequently until butter and chips are completely melted and ingredients are completely combined. Add vanilla extract and all spices, stir well. Pour mixture into prepared pan (make sure pan is on a heatproof surface). Allow fudge to cool completely before cutting (this will take several hours at room temperature or refrigerate 1-2

hours).

Chai Tea Latte

8 ozs. cold water 2 black tea bags 1/2 tsp. honey or to taste 1/8 tsp. black pepper 1/8-1/4 tsp. ground ginger or 1/2 tsp. fresh ginger 1/2 tsp. cinnamon 1/8 tsp. ground cloves

1/8 tsp. nutmeg Pinch of sea salt 7 ozs. milk

1/2 tsp. vanilla extract

Whipped topping

Pour water into saucepan and bring to a boil. Add all the spices along with the teabags (take off the tags before placing in the water). Let simmer on low for 1-2 minutes. Add milk and bring back up to a simmer. Take off heat, carefully take out teabags and add vanilla extract. Let steep for about 1 minute. Strain and pour into a large mug. Add

As he opened the box, the father was embarrassed by his earlier overreaction, now regretting how he had punished her.




In a very real sense, each of us has been given an invisible golden box filled with unconditional love and kisses from our children, family, friends and God. There is no more precious possession anyone could hold.





For the man who hated Christmas

It's just a small, white envelope stuck among the branches of our Christmas tree. No name, no identification, no inscription. It has peeked through the branches of our tree for the past 10 years.

It all began because my husband Mike hated Christmas. Oh, not the true meaning of Christmas, but the commercial aspects of it-overspending and the frantic running around at the last minute to get gifts given in desperation, because you couldn't think of anything else.

Knowing he felt this way, I decided one year to bypass the usual shirts, sweaters, ties and so forth. I reached for something special just

As the match began, I was alarmed to see that the other team was wrestling without headgear. It was a luxury the ragtag team obviously could not afford. Well, we ended up taking every

weight class. Mike, seated beside me, shook his head sadly, "I wish just one of them could have won," he said. "They have a lot of potential, but losing like this could take the heart right out of them." That's when the idea for his present came. That afternoon, I went to a local

sporting goods store and bought an assortment of wrestling headgear and shoes, and sent them anonymously to the inner-city church. On for Mike. The inspiration came in Christmas Eve, I placed a small, white envelope on the tree, the note inside telling Mike what I had done, and that this was his gift from me.

Mike's smile was the brightest thing about Christmas that year. And that same bright smile lit up succeeding years. For each Christmas, I followed the tradition—one year sending a group of mentally handicapped youngsters to a hockey game, another year a check to a pair

of elderly brothers whose home had burned to the ground the week before Christmas, and on and on.

The white envelope became the highlight of our Christmas. It was always the last thing opened on Christmas morning, and our children would stand with wide-eyed anticipation as their dad lifted the envelope from the tree to reveal its contents. As the children grew, the toys gave way to more practical presents, but the small, white envelope never lost its allure.

The story doesn't end there. You see, we lost Mike to cancer. When Christmas rolled around, I was still so wrapped in grief, that I barely got the tree up. But Christmas Eve found me placing an envelope on the tree. And the next morning. I found it was magically joined by three more. Unbeknownst to the others, each of our three children had, for the first time, placed a white envelope on the tree for their dad. The tradition has grown and someday will expand even further with our grandchildren standing to take down that special




